- **Gandhi/King Peace Scholarship**

The Gandhi/King Peace Scholarship provides a \$1,000 award to a currently enrolled community college student who best articulates the peaceful messages of Mahatma Gandhi and Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. This award has been endowed by retired Oakton Community College trustee Jody Wadhwa and the Oakton Educational Foundation. Each ICCTA member college may submit only one student entry per academic year.

- **Lifelong Learning Award**

The Lifelong Learning Award celebrates the accomplishments of currently enrolled Illinois community college students who have used their community college as a resource on multiple occasions.

- **Gregg Chadwick Student Service Scholarship**

The Gregg Chadwick Student Service Scholarship provides a \$500 award to a currently enrolled Illinois community college student for extraordinary commitment to volunteer service. Each ICCTA member college may nominate only one student per academic year.

• **Gary W. Davis Ethical Leadership Award**

The Gary W. Davis Ethical Leadership Award honors individuals who have made outstanding contributions to the pursuit and support of ethical leadership and decision-making in their fields of work and volunteer service.

• **Gigi Campbell Student Trustee Excellence Scholarship**

The Gigi Campbell Student Trustee Excellence Scholarship provides a one-time \$500 award to a currently serving student trustee of an ICCTA member board.

• **Distinguished Alumnus Award**

The Distinguished Alumnus Award recognizes the many success stories of the state's community college graduates.

• **Professional Board Staff Member Award**

The Professional Board Staff Member Award recognizes exemplary professional service to an ICCTA member community college board.

• **Pacesetter Award**

The Pacesetter Award honors the success of more recent Illinois community college alumni (those completing a program or 30 semester hours after June 30, 2011).

• **Equity and Diversity Award**

This award recognizes exemplary commitment by an ICCTA member college board and its chief executive officer to achieve equity in the institution's education programs.

Deadline: March 25, 2022

• **Michael S. Monaghan Meritorious Service Award**

This honor is given to elected/appointed officials and other friends of community colleges who have contributed to the advancement of the Trustees Association and community college education in Illinois.

• **Honorary Membership**

As the association's highest award, Honorary Membership is reserved for those individuals who have established the very highest standard of service and who have clearly benefitted the entire Illinois community college system. Currently serving trustees and presidents are not eligible for nomination.

• **Certificate of Merit**

The Certificate of Merit is presented to persons (usually former trustees or presidents) who have made a significant contribution to ICCTA, the Illinois system, or an individual member college. Currently serving trustees and presidents are not eligible for nomination.

• **Ray Hartstein Trustee Achievement Award**

This honor recognizes exemplary service by a currently serving trustee at an ICCTA member college.

Deadline: March 25, 2022

• **Business/Industry Partnership Award**

The Business/Industry Partnership Award recognizes an Illinois business that has built a successful workforce-training alliance with an ICCTA member college.

• **Outstanding Full-Time Faculty Member Award**

The Outstanding Full-Time Faculty Member Award recognizes the high achievement of Illinois' full-time public community college instructors.

• **Outstanding Adjunct Faculty Member Award**

The Outstanding Adjunct Faculty Member Award recognizes the high achievement of Illinois' part-time public community college instructors.

• **Advocacy Award**

The ICCTA Executive Committee created this special award in 2006 to honor dedicated leadership in advocating for the needs of students and community colleges.

• **Paul Simon Student Essay Contest**

The Paul Simon Student Essay Contest provides a one-time \$500 scholarship to the student who best describes "How My Community College Has Changed My Life." All currently enrolled students at ICCTA member colleges are eligible to participate; however, each college may enter only one student entry in the statewide competition per academic year.
