# **ICCTA Board Highlights**

Notes from the ICCTA Board of Representatives' February 6-7, 2023, meetings, held in person in conjunction with the Community College National Legislative Summit in Washington, D.C.

## ADVOCACY FEDERAL ISSUES



How many Illinois trustees can you identify in this photo from ICCTA's February 7 meeting with U.S. Senators Dick Durbin and Tammy Duckworth in Washington, D.C.?

- Received briefings on community colleges' 2023 federal legislative priorities;
- Voted to support the proposed 2023 Farm Bill, which includes Capacity Building Grants for community college agriculture and natural resources programs;
- Hosted a constituent meeting with U.S. Sens. Dick Durbin and Tammy Duckworth of Illinois on short-term Pell grants, workforce training, and the healthcare professional shortage; and
- Shared ideas on promoting <u>Community College Month</u> in April, including recruiting current students to return to their high schools to discuss how community college has influenced their lives; and
- Endorsed Amanda Howland (Lake County) for re-election to the Association of Community College Trustees' Board of Directors.

#### **STATE ISSUES**

- Discussed state legislation of interest to Illinois community colleges:
  - o <u>House Bill 1005</u>: Requires the City Colleges of Chicago to provide nursing programs at each college
  - o House Bill 1013: Requires all public universities and community colleges to provide childcare
  - House Bill 1055: Requires free community college tuition in areas designated as R-3 under the Cannabis Regulation and Tax Act
  - o House Bill 1133: Allows a community college district to spend down its Working Cash Fund to zero

- <u>House Bill 1264</u>: Requires trustee subdistricts in college districts with a population above 300,000
- o House Bill 1408: Allows public bodies to continue conducting meetings via audio or video conference
- o House Bill 1630: Establishes a pilot bachelor of science in nursing program
- o Senate Bill 93: Requires greater accountability for-profit colleges (cap on default rates)
- o <u>Senate Bill 150</u>: Requires public universities and community colleges to adopt free-speech policies
- Were informed that the Illinois Board of Higher Education has adopted the <u>7.5% funding increase</u> recommended by the Illinois Community College Board. Gov. JB Pritzker will deliver his Fiscal Year 2024 budget address on February 15;
- Learned that ICCTA will draft a letter for trustees to send to members of the Illinois General Assembly's higher education committees from their college districts; and
- Acknowledged Dr. Maureen Banks (Parkland), who was recently appointed by Gov. Pritzker as ICCB's trustee representative.
