## **ADVOCACY**

- Recognized Illinois Governor JB Pritzker with ICCTA's 2023
  Michael S. Monaghan Meritorious Service Award;
- Welcomed Illinois Secretary of State Alexi Giannoulias as ICCTA's November 10 luncheon keynote speaker;
- Adopted ICCTA's 2024 State Legislative Goals;
- Learned that the Illinois Council of Community College Presidents has formed an <u>Illinois Manufacturing Workforce</u> <u>Ecosystem</u> task force to develop new ways to deliver training and curriculum;
