

QUICK SURVEY RESULTS Condolence Letters

February 21, 2023

A total of <u>20</u> colleges/districts responded to ICCTA's Quick Survey on CONDOLENCE LETTERS.

HIGHLIGHTS:

- More than half (60%) of responding colleges send a condolence letter to the families of current students who have passed away.
- The condolence letters are prepared by the President's office or an administrator affiliated with student services.
- Several colleges also send a donation or floral arrangements to the student's memorial service.

DOES YOUR COLLEGE SEND OUT CONDOLENCE LETTERS TO FAMILIES OF STUDENTS WHO HAVE PASSED AWAY? IF YES, WHAT INFORMATION IS INCLUDED IN THE LETTER?

<u>YES 12</u> DuPage:	The Office of the President will send a condolence letter to the family of a passing student.

Harper	
Illinois Central:	Yes, we send letters. However, there isn't a template, as one of the Vice Presidents personally hand-writes a message to the family on a branded sympathy card.
Illinois Valley	
Joliet:	JJC sends a condolence card from the President and a dish garden on behalf of the college to the service.
Lake Land:	Lake Land College sends a college memorial, or a donation as mentioned in the obituary, to the services along with a card of sympathy from the Lake Land College Board of Trustees and President Bullock.
Oakton:	Oakton sends two letters: One from Student Affairs with a tuition refund check, and one from the President.
Rock Valley:	The Dean of Students office at Rock Valley College sends condolence letters. We do not have a template.
Spoon River:	Spoon River College doesn't have a template for condolence letters. The letters are personalized and specific to the family of the student.

Triton:	Yes, but there is no template as this is handled on an individual basis.	
Wright:	Wright does send out condolence letters but we don't have a template.	
<u>NO 8</u> Danville:	The president's office has sent condolence cards, though, that are similar to the ones we send to families of deceased employees and alumni.	
Highland:	If it is a current student, we send a plant to the funeral or a donation to the memorial, depending on the family's preference.

The Dean of Students will follow the <u>Death of a Student/Former Student Admin Procedure</u> in these situations.

The communication to the family is in the form of a handwritten note on ECC Dean of Students office stationary, and is fairly simple.

The note contains the following information:

- Expressing condolences for the family's loss on behalf of Dean of Students and the College
- Assurance that the student's record at the College will be closed and current term tuition refunded (if applicable)
- Provide Dean of Student contact information and offer to answer any question or concern the family may have regarding the College procedure in these situations

If we learn of the student's passing prior to the service being held, we request Student Life to send flowers to the service on behalf of ECC and the Dean will attend the service.

For current students who have passed away, a letter is sent from the president to their next of kin.

Sample body of letter here:
